There is an interesting new competitive fishing format available now. Here is how it works. You pay 18.00 in fees. This enters you for one week. During that week, you can fish as often as you wish, and for many different species. The minimum lengths are about the same as Michigan Master Angler lengths. For example, the minimum length for large mouth bass is 22 inches. If you boat one that length or greater, you photo it with a digital camera on a slap stick, or ruler. You take one additional photo of the fish. You then get a certain number of points for the minimum length, and additional points for every 1/4 inch greater than that. If the fish you submit has the greatest amount of points for that week, you get 500.00. Just about every legal fish in Michigan is included.
